IMPORTANT REMINDERS:

PICK UP – All sailors MUST be promptly picked up by 3:00 PM Monday through Thursday and by Noon on Fridays. Instructors must leave on time.

Regattas

- **Registration** – It is your responsibility to mail or drop off all regatta registration forms, not the coaches.
- **Forms** – A folder was handed to all sailors with the appropriate regatta information and corresponding forms.
- **Awards** – All awards are dispensed at the hosting yacht club. For all down bay regattas the sailors sail to TRYC after the last race, de-rig and are transported back to the hosting club for awards.
- **Up Bay Regattas** – Parents are responsible for the **regatta registrations** (we recommend mailing ahead of time) and getting the **sailors boat** to and from the regatta. Up Bay regattas are those North of the Seaside Bridge.
- **Time Change** – For certain regattas and Interclubs coaches may request sailors arrive earlier than usual to rig.
